



## ACCESSIBLE HOUSING

A property may be considered accessible to people with disabilities if it has level thresholds, elevators or ramps instead of stairs, wide door openings, and restrooms with grab-bars. The apartment complexes listed below have units that were specially designed or have been modified to accommodate people with disabilities.
